What is Love Bites?

Love Bites is an extremely successful Domestic and Family Violence and Sexual Assault prevention program that has evolved on the Mid North Coast of NSW for school based education. The program has been successfully delivered in schools and community based group education sessions for young people aged 14 to 17 years. The Love Bites Program consists of 2 interactive workshops on Domestic and Family Violence and Sexual Assault and then 2-3 workshops that consolidate the information from the morning workshops by working alongside the students/clients to create hip hop songs, drama pieces and artworks on the information that they have learned.



What is the Love Bites Train the Trainer Workshop?

The Love Bites train the trainer workshop has been developed by NAPCAN to train local workers and service providers in facilitating the Love Bites Program in their area. The training covers the history, aims and philosophies of the program, runs through the whole day group / school program, explains the community campaign and discusses challenges and troubleshooting. All participants are provided with a comprehensive training manual.

Who Should attend the Workshop?

The train the trainer package has been written for professionals who work in the area of Domestic and Family Violence and Sexual Assault or have an interest in or a responsibility for conducting violence against women prevention programs. These people can include: Sexual Assault Counsellors, Police Officers, Women's Centre Workers, Aboriginal Health Workers, Youth Workers, School Teachers, Drug and Alcohol Counselors, Child Protection Specialists, School Counsellors, Community Educators / Group Work Facilitators, Health Workers and Guidance Officers.
